

RESOLUTION # 2012 - 01

ADOPTING THE WASHBURN COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

FISCAL IMPACT: None

WHEREAS, the Town of Madge recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazard mitigation plan is required by FEMA as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Madge participated jointly in the planning process with Washburn County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan, which was made available for review via a Legal Notice and a copy of which will reside permanently in the Washburn County Emergency Management Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Madge, hereby adopts the Washburn County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Washburn County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Town of Madge, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Managements Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes been made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting the resolution.
