

Objectives

- 1) Construction and reconstruction of roadways through environmentally sensitive areas should be minimized
- 2) Develop safe off-road corridors for all types of recreational activities
- 3) Maintain a town roadway improvement program

- 4) Encourage public transit, ridesharing, carpooling, and disability transportation services in the town

Action-Plan

- A) Utilize construction standards set by the Corps of Engineers and DNR on road projects

- A) Identify areas where ATV, UTV, and snowmobile trails connect to the town of Madge and work with local clubs in the area to identify needs

- A) Conduct an annual road tour to review road conditions
- B) Utilize PASER to assist in road improvement projects

C) Conduct an inventory and evaluation of local culverts

A) Research funding organizations such as the Washburn County Health and Human Services Department, Washburn County Unit on Aging, and WisDOT
